The Ocean Fellowship Program is a funded research opportunity offered by TBA2T-Academy and field at Ocean Space in Venice, Italy. The 2021 edition is closely affiliated with the exhibition The Soul Expanding Ocean #17: Biol Harvin, to be held at Ocean Space. The fellowship also forms an integral part of The Current ((working title: The Mediterraneans: "Thus weves, come in pairs," after Etel Adnan), a transdisciplinary and transregional exercise in sensing, listening, thinking, and bearing with - by connecting and supporting situated projects, coliciolive pedagogies, and voices along the Mediterranean shores across the fields of art, culture, selonce, contensions, and according to the properties of the coliner, solveney contensions, and activities.

Eligibility
The Fellowship is aimed at undergraduate, master or Ph.D. level students, and recent graduates, while the Mentorship is asking for scholars with a graduate or postgraduate degree with some relevant experience in teaching or mentoring, specialized in various felted or research (e.g. Postcolonial and Fermistal Studies, Indigenous Studies, Anthropology, Political Science, Accessibility and Educations Sciences, engineering, material sciences, medicines, humanities, social sciences, Curatorial Studies, and Critical Theory). Arists from all fields are encouraged to apply both as Fellows and Mentors. Applicants should engage critically with the oceanic and explore new forms of research.

For the 2021 edition of the Ocean Fellowship, we are proudly partnering with Artis, who is supporting one fellow artist or researcher from Israel whose work addresses eastbatic, social, and political questions that inspire reflection and debate around oceans with an emphasis on the Mediterranean.

Budget and duration
The Cosan Fellowship Program will offer a total allowance of 5.500 EUR per
fellow for the 4-month duration of the program and a total allowance of 8.000 EUR
